LIBRARY and LIBRARIANS

- Due to the coronavirus the Library remained closed the month of January.
- Use of the options to check out circulating library items continues to be minimal, as does the use of Look Up requests. Most are a result of one-on-one conversations or emails.

SHELVING and the LIBRARY COLLECTION

- The Book Committee (Marilyn Ayres, Chloe Sternola, and Anne Billeter) continues to meet using Zoom.
- The Medford branch of the Jackson County Library District delivered the microfilm of the
 Oregonian (1/1/1964-12/31/2008) in 31 boxes and Kim recruited volunteers who picked up and
 delivered 3 lateral microfilm cabinets. The volunteers also moved our existing microfilm cabinet
 from Terry Fischer's office to the location in the Library adjacent to the Oregonian microfilm
 cabinets.
- The Book Committee has reviewed microfiche from the Barbara Freshwater estate and approved storing it in boxes that will fit in the bottom drawers of the Oregonian microfilm cabinets, which were empty. This means some of our microfiche will be in numbered binders and some will be in numbered boxes.
- 5 large boxes of quality genealogy books were donated. These will add some great resources to the Library collection and add some more books to sell.

- Bob Korth is preparing to sell our non-Amazon-eligible surplus books on eBay.
