## LIBRARIANS: April

- The Library was open 25 days, 150 open hours.
  - 35 librarians worked a total of 325 hours.
  - 5 new librarians received 10 additional training hours.

## LIBRARY: April

- Library use was up, with 92 patrons in April, for an average of 3.8 per day (not including April 29, the Coronation Event)
  - o 3 days with 0 patrons
  - o 2 days with 1 patron
  - 4 days with 2 patrons
  - 4 days with 3 patrons
  - o 1 days with 4 patrons
  - 2 days with 5 patrons
  - o 5 days with 6 patrons
  - o 1 day with 7 patrons
  - o 1 day with 9 patrons
  - o 1 day with 10 patrons
- 1 meeting, 1 program and 1 event brought additional visitors
  - 6 signed in for DAR meeting, but more attended
  - Member Meeting and Program (hybrid)
  - Coronation Event (26 signed at the Reception Desk)

## LIBRARY COLLECTION
