Treasurer's Report

Kim Thurman reported notable income for August included dues from new and returning members, a large Annual Fund Drive contribution of \$5000 and the fees from the Digital Scrapbooking Class.

Noteworthy expenses were two power bills due to the billing cycle, the payment of Diya Patel's scholarship to University of Oregon, and the ordering of a new Panasonic projector. Copy fees were also higher due to our table at the OLLI Open House.
