RVGS is an all volunteer, non-profit organization founded in 1966. The society promotes family history research by providing educational and research opportunities at our library, through our website, and virtually. The mission of RVGS is to inspire interest in genealogy, inform and educate the public, and maintain a growing sustainable library with a strong online presence.

The RVGS Library has an extensive collection of birth, marriage, and death records; family histories, books, bulletins, cemetery records, obituaries, maps, microfilm and microfiche, and newspaper abstracts about every state and many countries. Indexes to Rogue Valley records can be searched on our website, and world-wide resources can be found in our online catalog of over 23,000 items.

The library has computers available for use with subscriptions to many popular genealogical research sites. Our subscription sites can be accessed on personal devices while in the library, and many are available remotely to our members.

RVGS members may use the library resources free of charge during open hours. Non-members may use the library for a fee of \$5.00 per day.

RVGS Membership is available to all interested persons for \$40 a year and includes all the listed privileges. A second household member may join for just \$15 extra. Lifetime memberships are also available.
